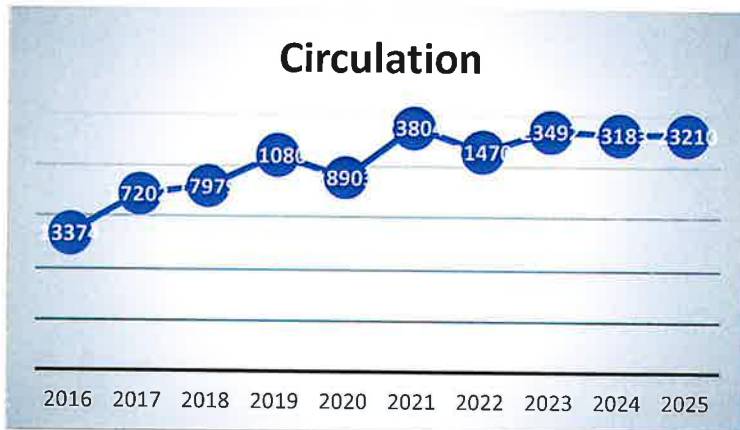
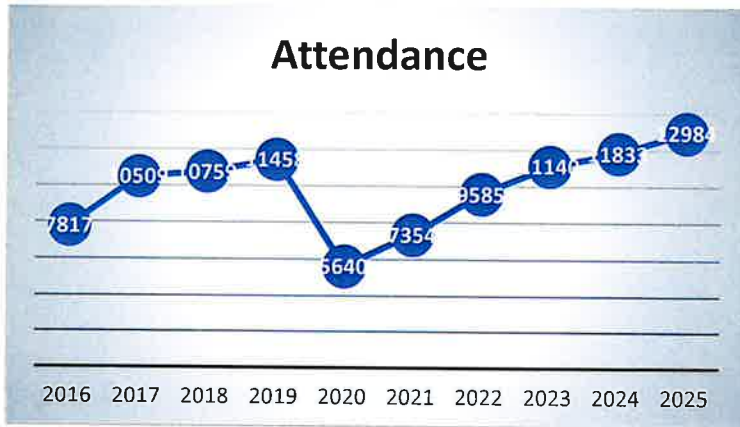


2025 Director's Report
